Floral, guava and citrus aromas with tropical fruit and a balancing acidity. Super value, super tasty.				
Mistico Branco, Ai Galera, Tejo , Portugal				26.00
Light, lifted and packed with vibrant citrus and fruit flavours. Ripe tropical and stone fruits balance with a cracking acidity and floral finish.				
Pinot Grigio, Umbrele, Transylvania, Romania				26.00
Opulent grapefruit and peach on the nose, with loads of orchard fruits, melon, and citrusy acidity. Really tasty and moreish Pinot Grigio!				
Chardonnay, 'The Googly', One Chain Vineyards, Australia	4.75	7.00	9.50	28.00
Bright ripe melon and apple characters couple with touches of pear and honey and a lick of oak on the finish. Textured, fruity, and really well balanced.				
Pecorino, PEMO, Abruzzo, Italy				29.00
Super fresh and zingy wine bursting with lively citrus acidity, notes of tropical fruits and a hint of minerality on the finish.				
Rioja Blanco, Finca Manzanos, Spain				32.00
Fabulous pear aromas on the nose. Bright and fresh, with hints of citrus, orchard, and stone fruits. Rounded, long and balanced.				
Viognier, Domaine Gayda, Languedoc, France	5.75	8.50	11.50	34.00
Quince, herbs, and stone fruit on the nose. Fresh and intense, with flavours of apricot, bergamot, acacia and lime, with a slight bitter almond finish.				
Grillo Appassimento, Miopasso, Sicily, Italy	6.00	9.00	12.00	36.00
Notes of dried fruits and nuts, with hints of oranges and grapefruit. The palate is soft and well-rounded, with touches of honey on the long finish.				
Gruner Veltliner, Funkstille, Niederostereich, Austria				36.00
Subtle exotic hints, ripe pear and fresh citrus flavours, it's a dry wine with complex flavours. The palate is rich with flavours of melon and grapefruit with a refreshing, zippy finish.				
Sauvignon Blanc, Snapper Rock, Marlborough, New Zealand	6.70	10.00	13.50	38.00
A classic, vibrant nose of tropical fruits such as passion fruit that carry through to the palate and are joined by a crisp citrus tinged edge to the mouth watering acidity.				
Picpoul de Pinet, Cave l'Ormarine, Languedoc, France	5.50	8.25	10.50	39.00
Vibrant and fresh on the palate with ripe mango fruit, a slightly salty edge and underlying minerality. Classic Picpoul at it's best.				
Bacchus Fume, Flint Vineyards, Earsham, Norfolk				48.00
Pear tart, lime cordial and almond on the nose with a soft, creamy mid-palate packed with nutty tones, sherbet lemons, elderflower, and lightly smoky on the finish. A superb expression of Bacchus.				
Chablis, Domaine Fournillon, Burgundy, France				49.00
Rich and textured, but crisp and fresh with plenty of citrus fruit and lovely limey acidity running through it. Good depth with classic slatey minerality. Really excellent Chablis!				
Pouilly Fume, Domaine Pierre marchand, Loire Valley, France				54.00
A complex, concentrated example of Pouilly Fumé with well balanced, crisp gooseberry and blackcurrant leaf fruit overlaid with hints of citrus and mineral. The finish is elegant and long with hints of flint and ripe apple.				
Sancerre, Noel et Jean-luc Raimbault, Loire Valley, France				55.00
Exemplary Sancerre from the holy trinity of soils; Caillottes, Terres Blanches, and a remarkably high proportion of Silex. Linear, mineral driven, citrusy, with a slight herbal edge, and a tangy finish. Everything you could possibly want in a glass!

Central Coast Chardonnay, Calera, California, USA				62.00
Inviting, indulgent Chardonnay which combines fresh, precise fruit and buttery richness. Aromas of lemon zest, green apple, cedar and passionfruit. With mouth-coating waves of tropical fruit balanced with natural acidity, and hints of toasted brioche on the finish.				

Puligny Montrachet, Gaele et Jerome Meunier, Burgundy, France				89.00
Relative newcomers to Burgundy, the Meunier brothers set up their own winery in 2011 and have gone from strength to strength. A mineral focussed style of Puligny. There is great depth, hints of oak influence, and lovely apple and citrus notes, but the emphasis is on freshness, vibrancy and a long clean finish.

Sangiovese, Ke Bonta, Italy				25.00
A fresh, medium-bodied style with red and black berry fruit characters, and a hint of spice balanced by tangy acidity.				

Merlot, La Barbe, Languedoc, France	4.25	6.25	8.50	25.00
Spicy, medium bodied wine with distinct notes of plums, black cherries, and jammy cassis. Soft, smooth, and easy drinking.				

Shiraz, Blockhead, South Africa	4.50	6.75	9.00	27.00
It's fresh, vibrant, positively thumping with sappy cherry fruit. The grip is there but perfectly balanced with a classy spiciness.				

Pinot Noir, Umbrele, Transylvania, Romania	5.00	7.25	9.70	27.00
Full to the brim of soft and welcoming flavours of black cherry, raspberries, cinnamon, and spices. Very generous with a lovely, elegantly smooth finish. Superb value!				

Rioja Tempranillo, Finca Manzanos, Spain	5.25	7.75	10.50	30.00
A lovely fresh, youthful Rioja with ripe cherry and berry fruit flavours and hints of spice. Medium bodied, soft, rounded, and highly approachable.				

Shiraz/Cabernet, The Wrong Un, One Chain Vineyards, Australia				30.00
A well-balanced example of the Aussie classic blend of Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon. It has lush black fruits coupled with a touch of wood-spice, liquorice and cassis that follows through to a delicious velvety finish.				

Malbec, Man Meets Mountain, Mendoza, Argentina	5.75	8.50	11.50	34.00
A harmonious Malbec, packed full of blueberry, blackcurrant and plum and a complex and delicious finish. Everything you would expect from Mendoza Malbec, and more.				

Primitivo, Miopasso, Puglia, Italy	5.75	8.50	11.50	34.00
Full of rich black cherries, blackberries and plums with a savoury feel, good texture and smooth, rounded tannins.				

Cabernet Franc, Mont Rocher, Languedoc, France				37.00
Luscious and mouth-watering, blackcurrant and redcurrant fruit characters. Fresh and vibrant with a twist of nutmeg, pencil shavings, and clove through to the finish.				

Pinot Noir, The Odd Lot, California, USA				38.00
Bang for buck, this Pinot Noir offers superb quality and truly great value for money. Lush aromas of black cherry and plum lead into flavours of bright red cherry and raspberry, with a hint of mocha and toasty oak.				

Ribera del Duero, Emilio Moro, Finca Resalso, Spain				39.00
Aromas of smoky oak and roasted black cherries. In the mouth, it's supple with abundant ripe dark fruit on the palate. There's a firm grain of tannin on the finish. Richness is lifted by a zest of acidity. Rich, but deliciously fresh and balanced.				

Toscana IGT, Monte Antico, Tuscany, Italy				40.00
This baby Super Tuscan really overdelivers across the board and is a real crowd pleaser. Leather, black cherries, liquorice and plums leading to ripe red fruit along with subtle notes of lingering vanilla and violets. Soft tannins, silky texture, and nigh on perfect tannins.				

Montagne-St Emilion, Franc Baudron, Bordeaux, France 43.00
Bright and intense in colour with aromas of blackcurrant, blackberry and oak notes. Well balanced, powerful and velvety. A classy Bordeaux that is drinking beautifully.

Gran Reserva Rioja, Cerro Anon, Spain 49.00
The wine opens up with ripe red berry aromas, smoky nuances and hints of spice, which develop into leather, coffee, and raisins. This follows through in flavour with prominent red fruits and stewed darker fruits. Firm, elegant and smooth, with a long and fresh finish.

Chateaneuf du Pape, Chateau Fargueirol, Rhone Valley, France 55.00
Full-bodied, creamy and supple in feel, it delivers waves of ripe black cherries and plums along with a touch of mocha. It's tannic but ripe and turns silky on the long, mouthwatering finish

Amarone della Valpolicella Ripasso, Cantina di Negrar, Italy 65.00
Intense and persistent, ethereal and fruity, with hints of cherries and dried prunes, dried flowers and spices. Full bodied and very smooth, with beautifully balanced, velvety tannins and a beautiful, balancing acidity.

ROSE

Grenache Rose, Sabina Estate, Navarra, Spain	4.25	6.25	8.50	25.00

Absolutely brimming with candied red fruits, sweet spices, mouth watering acidity and a finish of bitter orange.

Solera Orange Wine, Cremale Recas, Transylvania, Romania 35.00
A perfect introduction to Orange Wines. Orange wines are made in the same style as reds and rosé, they just use white grapes! Aromas of Orange peel, Poire William, and a hint of vanilla. Elegant fruit flavours of dried apricot, orange and honey backed up with a gentle tannin structure.

St Louis de Provence, Estandon, Provence	6.15	9.25	12.30	38.00
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Fresh, vibrant and pale pink in colour. Dry in style with aromatic rose petals on the nose, this wine follows through with notes of cranberry and strawberry fruits on the palate with a mouthwatering finish.

Les Deux Anges, Ch. L'escarelle, Provence 49.00
Aromas of pink cherries and nectarines with dried tangerine peel, almonds and dried flowers. Medium-bodied and creamy with some salinity to it. Crisp and juicy with a fleshy finish. This is an archetypal Provence Rose.

SPARKLING

Beppe Morchetta Spumante, Veneto, Italy	7.00	28.00

Delicate white peach and citrus notes, with an appealing bitter twist on the finish. Fine bubbles, with appealing fruity character through to the finish.

Cremant de Limoux, Antech, Languedoc, France 37.00
Limoux is the birthplace of traditional method sparkling wine, some 100 years before Dom P 'invented' it. The nose expresses the spring flowers and fresh tree fruits. The palate is lively, harmonious and round. We have the feeling to bite in a very delicate granny smith apple.

Charmat Rose, Flint Vineyard, Norolk 12.50 50.00
Summer in a glass. Red berries on the nose that is reminiscent of Summer Fruit Pudding! This fruit carries forward to the palate, which is soft and round with a slight caramelisation and refined effervescence.

Pierre Mignon, Premier Cru, Brut NV Champagne, Reims, France 16.25 65.00
Pinot-dominated, it's deep copper/gold and wonderfully peachy and lush, explosively juicy, and cracking value. The extended bottle ageing of this wine (6-8 years) is way longer than most NV Champagnes and lends the wines its weight and character. But it's also fresh and lemony which is such a great combination.

Louis Roederer, Brut NV Champagne, France 90.00
Perhaps the finest of the Grande Marque Champagnes? Fine bubbles and a nose of fresh fruit and hawthorn. Smooth, complex palate mingling flavours of apple and pear with blackberries, raspberries and cherries. This is a structured and elegantly mature wine, lively on the mouth with a smooth palate.
